Featured Fitness Aerobic Classes

Abs, Buns & Thighs: Warm up your muscles doing floorwork concentrating on your abdomen, glutes and thighs. May include weight use.

Balance Ball Fitness: Work your upper and lower body by strengthening, toning and conditioning your core muscles using proper alignment. Stretching techniques will also be incorporated.

Body Blast: Total body conditioning combining aerobics with weight training as well as balance ball, exercubes, and/or step, in order to strengthen, condition, align and shape the even development of all muscle groups.

Cardio Core: Using controlled movement, this is a great class for strength and muscle conditioning for both the upper and lower body. May include weight use.

Cardio Kickboxing: This dynamic class offers both kickboxing and dancing to upbeat music. Work out at your own pace!

Cycle & Sculpt: 40 minutes of cycling and 10-15 minutes of lunges, push-ups and abdominal sculpting.

Cycling: Indoor, multi-level cycling for a great cardio workout.

Hi/Lo Aerobics: A fast-paced, high energy aerobic class, combining choreographed high and low impact movement. Light weights and floor work may be included for cool down.

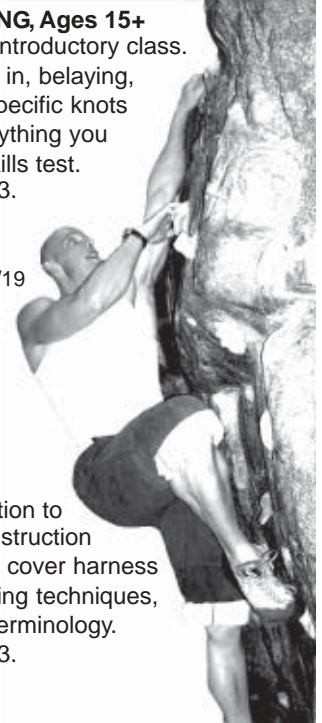
